Donate a vacation home or timeshare	Host a family for the weekend or let someone else enjoy it for a week!			
Donate Season Pass tickets	Bruins Hockey, Patriots Football, Celtics Basketball, Red Sox Baseball, Revolution Soccer, Boston Children's Museum or Museum of Science			
Donate Frequent Flyer Miles	If you have an abundance of FF miles and you know that you won't/can't use all of them, consider donating some miles for a trip for one or two lucky persons!			
Share your talents	Gardening, landscaping, handyman, organizing, music lessons for kids, cooking or babysitting			
Food of the Month Club	Prepare and deliver a special dessert, soup, pasta or meal to the winning bidder each month			
Offer handmade items	Hand-knit scarves, sweaters, costumes, jewelry, paintings, sculptures and greeting cards
